The State Recital Competition is a competition to choose chapter Representatives for the WSMETA State Conference Honors Recital and Alternates for the District I Honors Recital. The State Conference Honors Recital will be held in Tacoma on **June 19-21, 2019** and the District I Honors Recital will be held in Everett on **April 28, 2019** at 2:30 pm. [Please mark these dates on your calendar before entering this competition.](#)

- Age: Entrants must be age 19 and younger. Adults and college students are excluded.
- A student must perform two solo pieces in the Chapter Educational Music Artistry Program.
- The soloists must perform both pieces from memory at their MAP event.
- A teacher may enter a student in only one chapter's State Recital Competition.
- Each student will perform **two memorized pieces** from different musical periods. According to the state rule, **each piece must not exceed 5 minutes in length.** It is the teacher's responsibility to time the pieces and **make necessary cuts** to stay under the 5-minute limit (10 minutes total time).
- Student performances will be timed at the State Conference Honors Recital. Any student whose performance exceeds 5 minutes will be stopped.
- Individual movements of suites, sonatas or other groupings by the same composer that can be performed as musical units in themselves are permitted within the 5 minute time limit.
- Only original music is allowed; no revised or arranged pieces. **No photocopies.**
- The order of performance will be determined by lottery at the EMTA February meeting.
- Music substitutions may be made up to one week before the competition.
- The performance piece need not be the same as the piece performed in the Music Artistry Program. However, the piece that is selected at the State Recital Competition is to be played in the State Conference Honors Recital.
- Please bring music to the competition, but do not put personal names.
- Students who win but failed to perform at the State/District Honors Recital will be asked not to enter the competition the following year. (Exceptions; sudden illness, family emergency)
