The EMTA Musicianship Festival (EMF) is coming soon! The theme is “Welcome Aboard!” This year’s festival will be held Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup>, at the Edmonds United Methodist Church (8<sup>th</sup> and Caspers – close to downtown Edmonds) from approximately 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. It’s a fun “field day” of musical events. Students win a ribbon for each category they enter. They can enter up to 12 events, so they may very well take home a handful of ribbons!

The Edmonds Music Teachers Association (EMTA) holds this event primarily as a fundraiser for our annual Joan E. Brown Scholarship. 100% of the \$35.00/student fee goes to either cover expenses or to fund the scholarship.
